



Users with appropriate security access in StudentInformation can set up a district trust between their district and a JVS or district compact that has also purchased DataMap. All district trusts are set up in StudentInformation.

- 1 On the **District Trusts** screen, click **Add District Trust**.

- 3 In the **Trust Type** section, select the **DataMap** checkbox.

The trusted district can now view/print read-only information regarding interventions, RIMPs, state assessments, and data points from the home school. The trusted district's data displays with  on the **Student Roadmap** screen for students who attend both the home school and the trusted district.
