 When you upload an attachment in DataMap, the file size is now restricted to a default value of 10 MB, and only the following default file types are accepted: .bmp, .csv, .doc, .docx, .gif, .jfif, .jpg, .jpeg, .odt, .ods, .pdf, .png, .ppt, .pptx, .tiff, .txt, .xls, and .xlsx. (*ProgressBook DataMap User Guide*)

Note: In the Web.config file, **AttachmentMaximumSize** and **AttachmentAcceptedFileExtensions** are now available in AppSettings. As an ITC, you can modify the default values for these settings at any time.

Resolved Issues

Importing Assessment Scores

 (D14870) Previously, when you imported i-Ready assessment scores, student scores from the initial attempt at the assessment instead of the most recent attempt displayed on the **Student Roadmap**, **Data Points**, and **Multiple Measures** screens because the scores from the most recent attempt were not imported successfully. Now, scores from students' most recent attempt at taking the i-Ready assessment are imported successfully and display on these screens as expected.

District Assessments

• (D14745) Previously, when you imported a district assessment with long benchmark names, performance-level descriptions, instructional recommendation descriptions, or scores on the **Multiple Measures** and **Data Points** screens, the assessment score rows and the student name rows became misaligned in the grid because the benchmark names, performance-level descriptions, instructional recommedation descriptions, and/or scores did not fit on 1 line. Now, these values are truncated with an ellipses (...) if they do not fit on 1 line. You can hover your cursor over a name to view the full name.

Student Interventions

 (D14749) Previously, when a staff member's account was inactivated after you assigned them as a student's intervention provider or referrer, you could not close the intervention because the staff member's name no longer displayed on the Edit Student Intervention screen in the Intervention Provider and/or Referred By drop-down list(s). Now, in this circumstance, the staff member's name remains in the drop-down list(s) if selected previously, and you can close the intervention successfully.

 (E14823,14410) On a student's RIMP, when you enter or select a Start Date that does not fall between August 1 and May 30 of the school year in which the RIMP was created, an error message now displays and you cannot save the RIMP. (*ProgressBook DataMap User Guide*)

• On the Add Student Intervention and Edit Student Intervention screens, in the **Program** drop-down list, you can now enter keywords in the **Search** field to narrow the list of intervention programs that displays in the drop-down list.

Now, in this circumstance, the appropriate teacher's name displays in the field.
