Enhancements

Page Level Security

- (E12053) Administrators can now control whether the **GradeBook**, **Parent**, and **Student** roles can view transportation information on the **Schedule** screen in ParentAccess. (*ProgressBook ParentAccess Administration Guide*)

Student Profile

- (E11278) The student's homeroom has been removed from this screen to prevent parents from prematurely viewing schedule information.

Schedule

- The student's locker combination now displays only to the student and the student's primary contact. If a non-primary contact or GradeBook user attempt to view the combination, a message displays indicating they cannot view the combination. (*ProgressBook User Guide*)

Sign Up

- (E12133) On parent and student registration screens, the email address notes have been clarified to reflect that email addresses may be used for teacher communication purposes. (*ProgressBook User Guide*)

Sign In

- A page curl animation has been added to the top right of the screen; marketing information about ProgressBook or tips for using ParentAccess display when parents or students hover their cursors over it.

Resolved Issues

ParentAccess Login Activity Audit

- (D11506) Previously, when you selected the **No Account** option for the report, students who have ParentAccess accounts incorrectly displayed on the report. Now, when you run the report with the **No Account** option selected, only students without ParentAccess accounts display in the list.

Update Course

- (D12042) Because schedules are now read directly from StudentInformation, the **Exclude from Parent Access?** check box on the **Update Course** window in GradeBook was no longer hiding courses from ParentAccess. Now, the **Exclude from Parent Access?** check box correctly hides courses again.

Update Email Address

- (D11309) Previously, when teachers who had more than one staff record tied to their accounts updated their email addresses, the updated email address did not display in ParentAccess for classes linked to the non-primary record. Now, the email address updates for all staff records associated with the teacher, so it displays correctly in ParentAccess.

Alerts

- (D10490) Previously, when a class associated with a standards-based report card used a default setup, the **Alerts** screen did not display the correct mark types for low mark alerts. Now, in these circumstances, the correct mark types display.

Enhancements

Fees

- (E12223) Prior year fees are now included on this screen under headings that indicate to which year they apply. (*ProgressBook User Guide*)

Page Level Security

- Administrators can now control whether the **GradeBook**, **Parent**, and **Student** roles can view locker information on the **Schedule** screen in ParentAccess. (*ParentAccess Administration Guide*)

Registration Key Maintenance

- Performance on the **Search Results** tab has been improved.

ParentAccess Login Activity Audit

- (E11832) ParentAccess user sessions are now refreshed once a day, so the activity of parents and students who have selected the **Remember me** check box on the **Sign In** screen is now included on the report more accurately.

Resolved Issues

ParentAccess Account Maintenance

- (D12210) Previously, when you exported all of the ParentAccess accounts to a CSV file, for students with multiple middle names that had been separated by commas, each middle name displayed in a separate column, creating alignment issues. Now, when students have multiple middle names, the names are all contained in one **Middle Name** column.
- (D12017) Previously, though only one student account is allowed per student, you were able to create more than one student registration key. Now, you can only create one registration key per student.

Schedule

- (D12376) Previously, schedules displayed in ParentAccess before the start of school even with the **Hide schedules until start of school** option selected on the **District Setup** screen (**ParentAccess Administration > District Settings**) if the **School start date** did not have a date listed. Now, schedules do not display in ParentAccess in these circumstances.
- (D12397) Previously, schedules did not display in ParentAccess after integration with StudentInformation when schedules were set up in StudentInformation but not in GradeBook. Now, the **Schedule** screen does not honor the **Exclude from ParentAccess?** check box on the **Course** window, so only StudentInformation exclusions are reflected, allowing the schedule to display properly on the **Schedule** screen in ParentAccess.

View ParentAccess Website

- (D12482,12519) Previously, when you clicked **View ParentAccess Website** on the **Class Dashboard** in GradeBook, the student drop-down list that displays on the preview of the ParentAccess site was not in the same order as the teacher's class roster. Now, the order on the student drop-down list matches the teacher's class roster.

- (D87456, 87509) Due to a recent change in StudentInformation, some student contacts were missing addresses in the exported file. Now, the exported file contains addresses for all contacts.
