 The student ID in the header is now obscured with asterisks throughout ParentAccess, and students must click **Show** to view the student ID. (*ProgressBook User Guide*)

Sign In

- (D15464) Previously, on this screen, some items did not follow accessibility requirements.
 The following user interface changes have been made to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA):
 - The color of the **Sign In** button has been updated to provide greater contrast.
 - The Students Sign in with Google button can now be accessed using keyboard shortcuts.
 - The **Sign Up** button is now visible when the browser is zoomed to 200%.
 - Alternative text is now available for more items on the screen, such as the district greeting image.

Grade Details

 To comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), you can now use keyboard controls to select an option from the Class drop-down list.

Planner

 When attempting to view assigned homework and upcoming work, to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), you can now use keyboard controls to access the expand and collapse control.

User Interface

- To comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), screen readers can now identify when there are expandable and collapsible sections across the application.
- To comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), when you have your keyboard focused on the address bar of any screen, you can now press TAB to select **Skip to content** and go directly to the main content of the screen.

Frontline ProgressBook Parent and Student

 Parent/guardians and students can now download the Frontline ProgressBook Parent & Student mobile app from the Apple App Store or Google Play for Android. The process for logging in or registering is identical to the ParentAccess web app. (GradeBook Attendance Guide, GradeBook Principal Guide, GradeBook Teacher Guide, GradeBook Systems Manager Guide, ParentAccess Administration Guide, ProgressBook User Guide, VirtualClassroom Teacher Guide)

Note: Your district must enable ParentAccess and install ProgressBook Suite v20.4.1 in order for Frontline ProgressBook Parent and Student to function as expected.

Report Cards

 With the release of ProgressBook Suite v20.4.0, the Report Cards drop-down list displayed only Not Available, although users were able to view report cards still by clicking View Paper Report Card or View Paper History. Now, users can access report cards using the Report Cards drop-down list as expected.

Alerts

 (PBSIS-8513) Previously, when an assignment was shared with other classes in GradeBook and the teacher marked it as missing for a student, in ParentAccess, users received missing assignment alerts for each class with which the assignment was shared. Now, in this circumstance, users only receive missing assignment alerts for the class the student is taking.

Report Card

(PBSIS-9555) With the release of ProgressBook Suite v20.4.0, when you tried to access
the Report Card tab on a mobile device, an error occurred. Now, you can access the tab
successfully.
