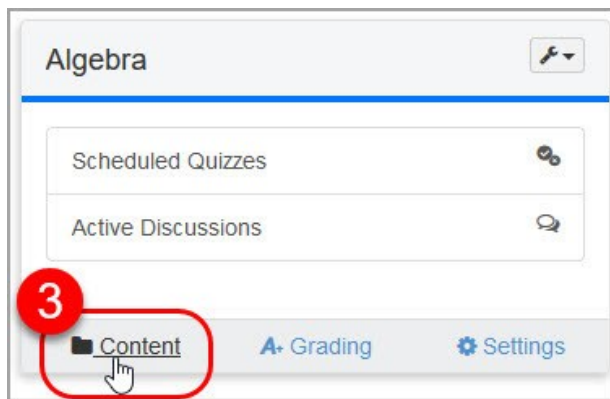
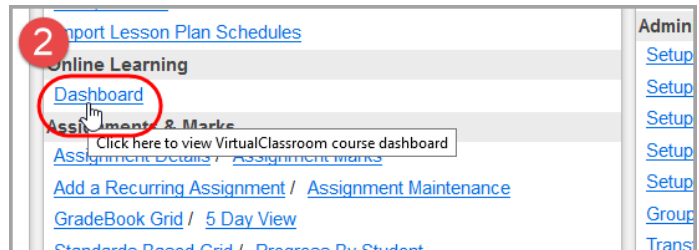

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# Access & Navigation

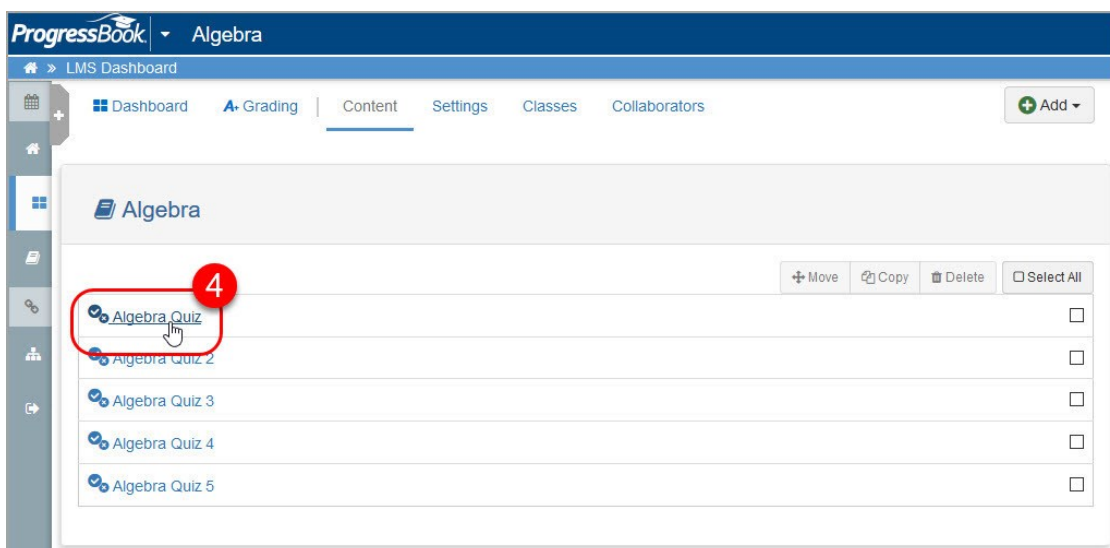
1. Log in to GradeBook.
2. On the **Teacher Home Page**, under **Online Learning**, click **Dashboard**.



3. Click **Content** on the course containing the quiz whose results you want to view.

The **Content** screen displays.

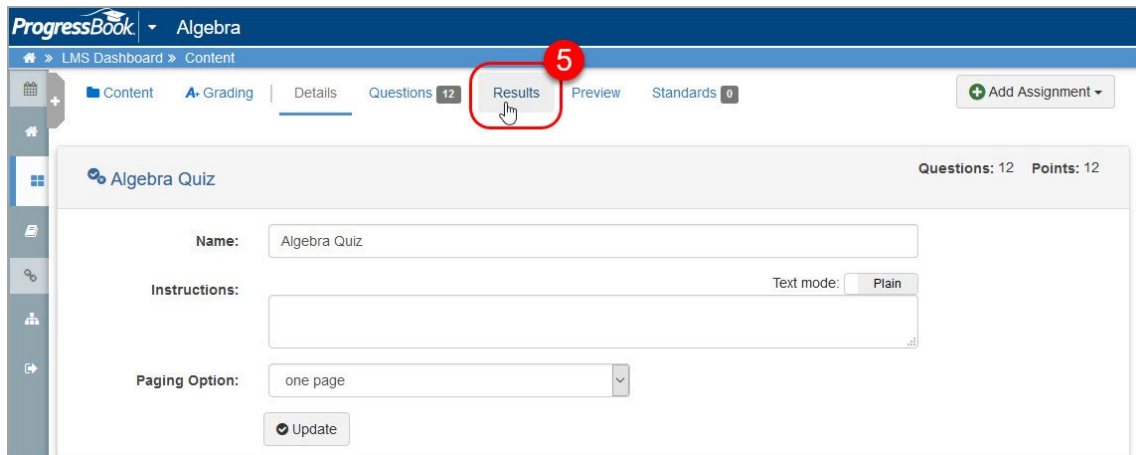
4. Click the name of the quiz whose results you want to view.

## *Interpreting Results*

In VirtualClassroom, you can begin viewing results for an activity once at least one activity has been graded. There are three ways in which you can view results:



by Question



by Standard



by Standard Summary



### *By Question*

Results for any quiz activities that have been graded can be viewed by question on the **Results** tab. Standards do not have to be attached to the quiz or to individual questions for you to be able to view these results.

1. In the **Class** drop-down list, select the class whose results you want to view.
2. Be certain that the **View By** drop-down list is set to **Question**.

### 3. View the results and analyze the data.

The area highlighted in **yellow** shows the mark that each student received on the quiz. The area highlighted in **pink** shows the answers the students gave for each question. The area highlighted in **orange** shows the number of students who answer each question correctly.

#### *You can use these results to consider the following:*

- Which questions did most students get correct? That content was probably covered thoroughly.
- Which questions did most students get incorrect? Maybe that content needs to be revisited, or maybe the question itself could be reworded.
- The content individual students have mastered or with which they are struggling.




## Interpreting Results (continued)

### By Standard

If you attached standards to individual questions on a quiz, you can view how students performed on individual standards rather than by question. If you had created multiple assignments for the same class, the assignments display in separate grids.

1. In the **Class** drop-down list, select the class whose results you want to view.
2. In the **View By** drop-down list, select **Standard**.

The area highlighted in pink shows the number of questions related to a particular standard with which a student was presented. The area highlighted in orange shows the class average of correct answers given per standard.



## **Interpreting Results (continued)**

**Note:** If “Not Presented” displays in any column on the grid, it means that the standard was not presented to the student in that row. This could happen if you published one version of the quiz to some students and another version to other students.

*You can use these results to consider the following:*

- Which standards are students mastering?
- Which standards are challenging the students?
- The standards individual students have mastered or with which they are struggling.

## **By Standard Summary**

If you attached standards to individual questions on a quiz, you can view how students performed on individual standards rather than by question. If you had multiple assignments in the same class for this activity, the assignments are all combined in one grid.

1. In the **Class** drop-down list, select the class whose results you want to view.
