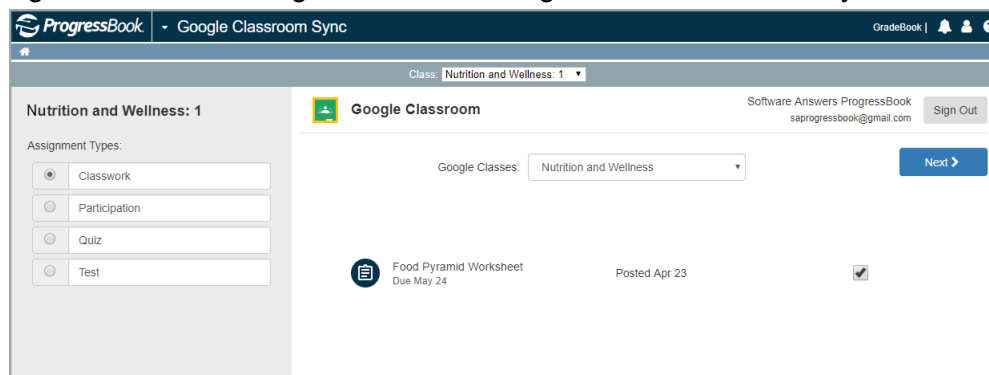
Enhancements

- Future enrolled students in StudentInformation now display in GradeBook before their admission date so that teachers can add them to classes or submit class lists to a third-party LMS.

- Previously, in the **Student** field, when you searched for a student with no middle name in the system by entering their name in the format [last name, first name] and then selected the student from the results list, no open tasks displayed for that student, even when the student had open tasks in SpecialServices.
