

## GradeBook

### Enhancement

#### Teacher Home Page > Report Card Entry > Comment for [Student] window

- When you enter a free-form comment on a report card that is set up to print from StudentInformation, the window now displays the number of characters you have entered out of 200 available. If you enter more than 200 and try to save the comment, you now also receive a warning message that indicates you have too many characters.

## Resolved Issues

### File Uploads

#### Class Information Page Maintenance, Homework Setup, Lesson Plan Maintenance, ParentAccess Preferences

- Previously, you were unable to upload a file attachment anywhere in GradeBook if you had an apostrophe (') in your username. Now, in this circumstance, you can upload files successfully.

### Google Classroom Sync

#### Class Dashboard > Google Classroom Sync

- Previously, after importing Google Classroom marks, you had to return to the **Class Dashboard** and click **Calculate Averages** to recalculate student averages in the class. Now, after importing Google Classroom marks, student averages are recalculated automatically.

### Mark Entry screens

#### 5-Day View, Assignment Marks, GradeBook Grid, Standards-Based Grid

- Previously, when you used the arrow keys to move your cursor within an editable field, the cursor instead moved from field to field. Now, you can use the arrow keys to move your cursor within the text in a field.

- On the **General** tab, the new **Previously Retained** field displays whether a student was retained at the end of a previous school year.

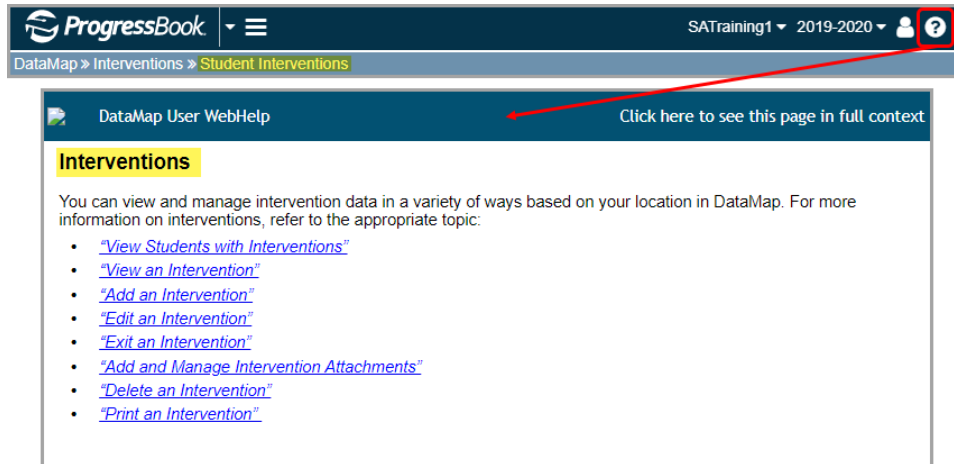

#### DataMap > Data Points

- Previously, when you clicked a column heading to sort third-party or district assessment data by that column, data sorted by the **Student** column instead of the column you selected. Now, when you click a column heading, data sorts by the correct column.

- Previously, when you clicked a column heading to sort district assessment data by that column, data sorted by the **Student** column instead of the column you selected. Now, when you click a column heading, data sorts by the correct column.
