

Google Classroom Sync

Class Dashboard > Google Classroom Sync


- You can now import assignments and marks from Google Classroom for your Custom Setup 2/standards-based classes. When you select a standards-based class from the **Class** drop-down list, the new **Assessments** area displays below the **Assignment Types** area. You can select one or more assessments from this area prior to selecting the **Google Class** and the assignment you want to import.

Notifications


- When enabled or required by your district or school, a notification is now generated when the report card entry window is open to remind you to enter report card marks.



Try New Seating Chart

Class Dashboard > Try New Seating Chart

- A preview of the new seating chart is now available via the **Try New Seating Chart** link. (The classic seating chart is still available via the **Seating Chart** link and will be deprecated in a future release.) The new seating chart offers an improved user interface.
- The new seating chart offers the ability to create one or more seating charts for each of your classes, class groups, and homerooms. You can customize the seating chart to fit your needs.
- Attendance functionality is not yet available. It will be available in a future release.



Resolved Issues

Mark Entry screens

5-Day View, Assignment Marks, GradeBook Grid, Standards-Based Grid

- Prior to this release, when you saved marks, the class average did not calculate when one or more students in the class were in a different grade level or school building than the grade level or school building assigned to the course. Now, in this circumstance, when you save marks, the class average calculates successfully.
- After the new mark entry screens were released, mark averages did not calculate for students who had been in Custom Setup 2/standards-based classes but were later withdrawn from the class or school, even when you clicked **Calculate Averages** on the **Class Dashboard**. Now, averages of students in these circumstances are calculated as expected.



Enhancements

Attendance filter

Home, Summary, Standards, Data Points, Multiple Measures

- The following updates have been made to the **Attendance** filter:
 - The new **Days/Hours** drop-down list lets you select whether you want to filter attendance by **Days** or **Hours**.
 - This filter now reads directly from student FS-Attendance records in StudentInformation.

Edit Student RIMP

DataMap > Interventions > RIMPs > Edit Student RIMP

- On the **General** tab **Additional Diagnostic Measures** window and the **Reading Component** tab **Add Progress Monitoring Measure** window, the new **Progress** drop-down list lets you select **Satisfactory**, **Unsatisfactory**, and **Progressing** options to indicate the student's progress on an additional diagnostic measure or progress monitoring measure, respectively.

DataMap > RIMPs > Edit Student RIMP > General tab

- On the **General** tab **Add Initial Screening Measure** window, in the **Assessment** drop-down list, you can now select **STAR Renaissance (New)** to add the Star assessment as an initial screening measure for a student's RIMP.

DataMap > Graduation Points


- When you select a **View Mode** of **Details** or **Graduation Pathways**, in the new **Workforce Readiness** section, the new **ACT WorkKeys v1.0** and **ACT WorkKeys v2.0** subsections now display student scores for the ACT WorkKeys and ACT WorkKeys Version 2.0 assessments, respectively.

Membership filter

Home, Summary, Standards, Data Points

- The new **Memberships** filter lets you filter your results by **Membership Groups**, **Memberships**, or **Ad Hoc Memberships**.

RIMPs

DataMap > Interventions > RIMPs

- When you enter or select a **Start Date** for a student's RIMP that does not fall between August 1 and May 30 of the school year in which the RIMP was created, an error message now displays and you cannot save the RIMP.

Student Interventions

Add Student Intervention, Edit Student Intervention

- In the **Program** drop-down list, you can now enter keywords in the **Search** field to narrow the list of intervention programs that displays in the drop-down list.

Resolved Issues

Standards

DataMap > State Assessments > Standards

- Previously, when a student took an assessment 3 or more times in the same school year, each attempt at the assessment displayed as a separate record instead of 1 record with an asterisk that indicated that the assessment was taken multiple times. Now, in this circumstance, the student's highest score on the assessment displays with an asterisk as expected.

Edit Student RIMP

DataMap > Interventions > RIMPs > Edit Student RIMP

- Previously, when a student was not enrolled in a Reading course but was enrolled in an English and/or Writing course, on the **General** tab, the name of the teacher who instructed the English or Writing course did not display in the **Reading Teacher** field. Now, in this circumstance, the appropriate teacher's name displays in the field.
