GradeBook

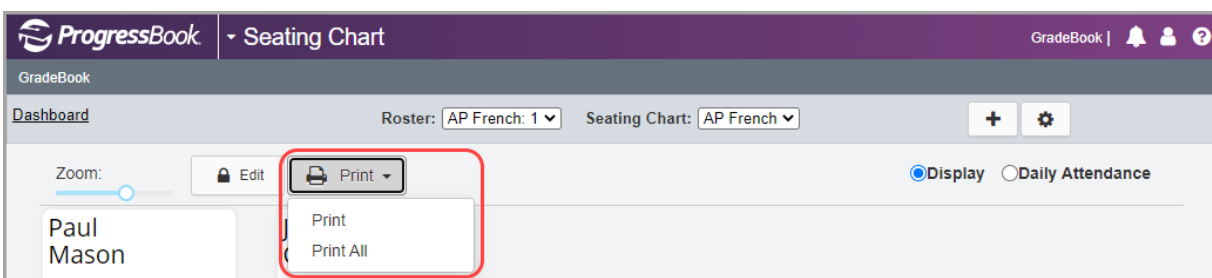
Enhancements

Dashboard

- When you hover your cursor over , the tooltip now states “Student has Special Education Documents.” ([GradeBook Teacher Guide](#))

Seating Chart

- When you click **Print**, you can now choose whether to print the current seating chart or all seating charts you have created for all classes. The print dialog opens in a new tab. ([GradeBook Teacher Guide](#))



Post Homework

- The user interface for adding or updating links and attachments has been improved.

Resolved Issues

Assignment Marks

- Previously, when an assignment was shared with other classes and the teacher marked it as missing, in ParentAccess, users received missing assignment alerts for each class with which the assignment was shared. Now, in this circumstance, users only receive missing assignment alerts for the class they are taking.

SpecialServices

Resolved Issues

Data Collection Form

- Previously, the services selected in the **Specially Designed Instruction** and **Support for School Personnel** sections of the **Service Plan** form did not display on the Data Collection Form (DCF). Now, these sections display as expected on the DCF for the **Service Plan** form.

User Interface

- Previously, when you were assigned the **SpecialServices - Administrator** role at A district and the **SpecialServices - General Education** role at B district, when you first logged in, the left navigation menu sometimes did not include the **Case Management** and **Settings** options for district A. Now, in this circumstance, the correct menu displays for district A.

- With the release of ProgressBook Suite v20.4.0, when you tried to preview certain Jefferson County Educational Service Center courses from the Public Library, an error occurred. Now, in this circumstance, you can preview these courses successfully.
